

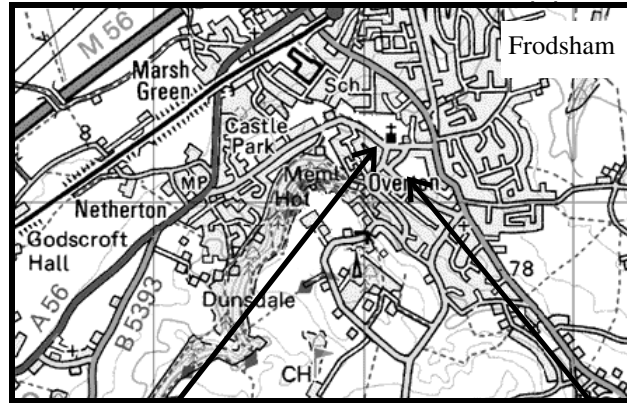

The music will be available in a single booklet on the day and the cost of hire is included in the ticket price.

Girlguiding UK is the United Kingdom's largest voluntary organisation for girls and young women, with over half a million members, more than 120 of these are based in Frodsham. Based at our Ship Street Headquarters, we have six units; 1 Rainbow unit (girls aged 5 - 7), 4 Brownie units (girls aged 7 - 10) and 1 Guide unit (girls aged 10 - 14) ably run by over 20 volunteer leaders and young leaders (aged 14-18).

We are very grateful to Frodsham & District Choral Society for helping us raise funds towards the repair of our Headquarters, a building on Ship Street, Frodsham. We have received a quote in excess of £2000 for this work. This historic building, previously the Police Station, has been a feature in Frodsham since about 1800. If you are interested in its history, please have a look at our poster in the school during the refreshment break.

Frodsham District Guides will be serving freshly prepared food in Frodsham Church of England primary school, from 5.15pm to 6.30pm (not included in the fee for the day).
